INITIAL RESOLUTION

(IAC Search, LLC Project)

A regular meeting of the City of Yonkers Industrial Development Agency was convened on January 23, 2013.

The following resolution was duly offered and seconded, to wit:

Resolution No. 01/2013-01

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF YONKERS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY (THE "AGENCY") (i) ACCEPTING THE APPLICATION OF IAC SEARCH, LLC WITH RESPECT TO A CERTAIN PROJECT (AS DESCRIBED BELOW) LOCATED IN BUILDING 4 AT 29 WELLS AVENUE, YONKERS, NEW YORK; (ii) AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC HEARING WITH RESPECT TO THE PROJECT; AND (iii) DESCRIBING THE FORMS OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE BEING CONTEMPLATED BY THE AGENCY WITH RESPECT TO THE PROJECT

WHEREAS, by Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, as amended, and Chapter 83 of the Laws of 1982 of the State of New York, as amended (hereinafter collectively called the "Act"), CITY OF YONKERS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY (hereinafter called the "Agency") was created with the authority and power to own, lease and sell property for the purpose of, among other things, acquiring, constructing and equipping civic, industrial, manufacturing and commercial facilities as authorized by the Act; and

WHEREAS, IAC SEARCH, LLC, a limited liability company having offices at 555 West 18th Street, New York, New York 10011, for itself or on behalf of an entity to be formed (the "Company"), has submitted an application to the Agency (the "Application") to the Agency requesting the Agency's assistance with a certain project (the "Project") consisting of the acquisition and installation of certain machinery, equipment and other items of tangible personal property (the "Equipment") in furtherance of the internal renovation by the Company of approximately 40,000 square feet of office space located in Building 4 of "iPark Yonkers," located at 29 Wells Avenue, Yonkers, New York (the "Facility"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law the Agency desires to adopt a resolution describing the Project and the financial assistance that the Agency is contemplating with respect to the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that the Agency will (i) designate the Company as its agent for the purpose of undertaking the Project and (ii) provide financial assistance (the "Financial Assistance") to the Company in the form of a sales and use tax exemption for purchases and rentals related to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Financial Assistance provided by the Agency to the Company under the Agent Agreement (as defined below) shall not exceed \$100,000 until a public hearing is held by the Agency and a subsequent resolution is adopted by the Agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act, Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law and the regulations adopted pursuant thereto at 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Part 617, as amended (collectively referred to as "SEQRA"), the Issuer must satisfy the applicable requirements set forth in SEQRA, as necessary, prior to making a final determination whether to undertake the Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF CITY OF YONKERS INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Company has presented an application in a form acceptable to the Agency. Based upon the representations made by the Company to the Agency in the Company's application, the Agency hereby finds and determines that:
- (A) By virtue of the Act, the Agency has been vested with all powers necessary and convenient to carry out and effectuate the purposes and provisions of the Act and to exercise all powers granted to it under the Act; and
- (B) It is desirable and in the public interest for the Agency to appoint the Company as its agent for purposes of undertaking the Project; and
- (C) The Agency has the authority to take the actions contemplated herein under the Act; and
- (D) The action to be taken by the Agency will induce the Company to develop the Project, thereby increasing employment opportunities in the City of Yonkers, New York and otherwise furthering the purposes of the Agency as set forth in the Act; and
- (E) The Project will not result in the removal of a civic, commercial, industrial, or manufacturing plant of the Company or any other proposed occupant of the Project from one area of the State of New York (the "State") to another area of the State or result in the abandonment of one or more plants or facilities of the Company or any other proposed occupant of the Project located within the State; and the Agency hereby finds that, based on the Company's application, to the extent occupants are relocating from one plant or facility to another, the Project is reasonably necessary to discourage the Project occupants from removing such other plant or facility to a location outside the State and/or is reasonably necessary to preserve the competitive position of the Project occupants in their respective industries; and
- (F) Based upon the review by the Agency of the Application submitted by the Company with respect to the Project, the Agency finds that the proposed action constitutes a "Type II action" pursuant to 6 N.Y.C.R.R. § 617.5 and therefore is exempt from review under SEORA

Section 2. Subject to the Company executing the Agent Agreement in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Agent Agreement") and the delivery to the Agency of a binder, certificate or other evidence of liability insurance policy for the Project satisfactory to the Agency, the Agency hereby authorizes the Company to proceed with the undertaking of the Project and hereby appoints the Company as the true and lawful agent of the Agency: (i) to undertake the Project; (ii) to make, execute, acknowledge and deliver any contracts, orders, receipts, writings and instructions, as the stated agent for the Agency with the authority to delegate such agency, in whole or in part, to agents, subagents, contractors, and subcontractors of such agents and subagents and to such other parties as the Company chooses; and (iii) in general, to do all things which may be requisite or proper for completing the Project, all with the same powers and the same validity that the Agency could do if acting in its own behalf; provided, however, the Agent Agreement shall expire on **December 31, 2013** (unless extended for good cause by the President/CEO of the Agency).

Section 3. The Chairman, Vice Chairman and/or the President/CEO of the Agency are hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to execute the Agent Agreement, a sales tax exemption letter (the "Sales Tax Exemption Letter"), and a bill of sale (the "Bill of Sale") whereby the Agency at the completion of the installation period transfers to the Company title to the Equipment acquired during the installation period by the Company as agent of the Agency, and related documents; provided, however, that the Financial Assistance provided to the Company by the Agency under the Agent Agreement shall not exceed \$100,000 until a public hearing is held and a subsequent resolution is adopted by the Agency.

<u>Section 4.</u> The Agency is hereby authorized to conduct a public hearing in compliance with the Act.

Section 5. The officers, employees and agents of the Agency are hereby authorized and directed for and in the name and on behalf of the Agency to do all acts and things required and to execute and deliver all such certificates, instruments and documents, to pay all such fees, charges and expenses and to do all such further acts and things as may be necessary or, in the opinion of the officer, employee or agent acting, desirable and proper to effect the purposes of the foregoing resolutions and to cause compliance by the Agency with all of the terms, covenants and provisions of the documents executed for and on behalf of the Agency.

Section 6. These Resolutions shall take effect immediately.
